2. President's Remarks:

- Opening and reading of Street Paving Bids-
 - Linde Construction bid was \$76,464
 - Hanson Aggregates bid was \$72,216
 President Sain stated the winning bid would be decided under new business later in the meeting.
- President announce the Dayne Losee received an award from the PA Association of Boroughs for 20 years of service on the council.

- Update from Steven Grandinali of PCLP-
 - PCLP renewed a 3yr contract for emergency service and will be reviewing storm protocol with EMA.
 - They will be starting a 10-year plan to replace all the gas lines in the Borough
 - They have also been replacing poles and continuing with general maintenance.
 - Online payment is available to residents as well as phone, mail, and paying in person at the PCLP office.
- Debbie Mireau of Hometown Heroes spoke asking for support in displaying Military Flags honoring service members in our community. The group is working out the logistics of where on Pennsylvania Ave. to hang the banners and for how long. Mayor Clark and the Enhancement Committee will work with Hometown Heroes on this project moving forward.

- Rosalyn Braeunig of 106 Ave F- Voiced concerns over high grass in her neighborhood.

1. Mayor: Janet Clark- Voiced support of Hometown Heroes banners, stating they will be of no cost to the Borough, as they are funded by sponsors. She suggested putting them up and taking them down with the American Flags on Pennsylvania Ave. The Enhancement Committee is working on getting 40 new flags for the street. There are 80 poles so there would be flags on every other pole.
